6. General information and Instructions:

- I. The appointment would be purely on contractual basis for a period of one year, renewable at end of term, subject to satisfactory performance and attainment of 65 years of age.
- II. Specialist Medical Officers will be recruited against specific health facility and they will not be permitted to engage in private practice. All the positions are non-transferable in nature and any request for relocation in future will not be entertained.
- III. The objective of the assignment for the Specialist Medical Officers is to effective operationalization of the identified First Referral Units under District Rural Health Society.
- IV. Interested candidates, fulfilling the eligibility criteria may appear in the walk-in interview with their detailed resume in the prescribed format, original certificates and Xerox copies of qualification certificates, work experience (if any), and one passport size photograph for the interview on the dates, venue & time mentioned above.
- V. These posts may be discontinued at any time depending upon the requirement or validity of the project.
- VI. Selected candidates will be required to remain at place of posting during duty hours. Specialist Medical Officers will have to reside within 8 KM of their place of posting. During off- duty hours they must be available on call within a response time of half an hour. They will be required to maintain their own mobile phones.
- VII. Society reserves the right to cancel any or all positions at any stage of recruitment process.
- VIII. At any stage of recruitment, it is found that candidate does not fulfill the eligibility criteria and/or that he/she has furnished incorrect/false information/certificate/documents or has suppressed any material fact(s), his/her candidature will stand cancelled. The decision of the Society in any matter relating to the recruitment at any stage of the recruitment process will be final and binding upon the candidates. No correspondence or personal queries in this regard shall be entertained.

Terms of service

1. In addition to the consolidated emoluments, the Specialist Medical Officer shall be entitled to receive such other benefits/compensation such as TA/DA allowance in tour/Trainings (at equivalent approved rates by the Government), casual leave and other gazetted leaves as notified by the Government of Jharkhand. However, he/she may be called on duty on leaves or gazetted holidays, in case of emergency.
2. As mentioned in section-1, Specialist Medical Officers will be entitled to only 16 days of casual leave and other gazetted holidays as notified in the first year of contract. Maternity and paternity leaves will be applicable for the specialist medical officer as per the State Government norms, subject to successful completion of first year of contract.
3. The appointment of the Specialist Medical Officer is purely on contract basis and would not be entitled to any claims, rights, interest or further benefits in terms of regularization or consideration of further appointment to the said post or any other post.
4. The Specialist Medical Officers will carry out the assigned responsibilities in accordance with the highest standard of professional and ethical competence and integrity, having due regards to the nature and purpose of the assignment and will conduct itself in a manner consistent herewith.
5. All Knowledge and information not within the public domain which may be acquired during the carrying out of this agreement, shall be, for all time and for all purpose, regarded as strictly confidential and held in confidence, and shall not be directly or indirectly disclosed to any person whatsoever, except with the Society's written permission.
6. The appointment will be issued on the understanding that all the information given by the Specialist Medical Officer in their application form and during the interview is complete and true. If any significant information has been knowingly suppressed, the Society will have the right either to withdraw this letter before the Specialist Medical Officer joins or terminate appointment at any time after the Specialist Medical Officer has taken up service with the Society without any notice or compensation.
7. The services of the Specialist Medical Officer would be terminable with proper logical reasoning by giving one month written notice or one month's remuneration in lieu of notice by either side. Services may also be terminated, in case the position is not required under the Society, with one month prior notice.
8. Any dispute arising out of the contract, which cannot be amicably settled between the parties, shall be referred to adjudication in accordance with Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
