The Directorate of Geology, Department of Mines and Geology, Government of Jharkhand (GoJ), is primarily responsible for carrying out geological and mineral exploration activities across the State. To support these operations, a **Press Palette Machine**—an essential tool for laboratory studies and geological and mineral exploration—is required by the Directorate of Geology.

Accordingly, sealed quotations are invited from reputed and eligible firms/suppliers under the Two-Bid System (Technical Bid and Financial Bid) for the supply of Press Palette Machine for the official use in the Directorate of Geology, Jharkhand.

2. SCOPE OF WORK AND SPECIFICATION:

Supply of a “Press Palette Machine” as per the technical specifications mentioned below:

1. The instrument should be automatic and fully programmable hydraulic Pellet Press with auto ejection to prepare pellets from powdered sample, should be suitable for EDXRF, WDXRF, & other analytical instruments.
2. The machine should have dual column high frame stiffness and floor mounted.
3. Maximum Pressure of 40 tons with digital display of set and actual load. Customized pressure variation facility from 5 to 40 tons. It should be PLC Controlled with touchscreen digital display with display of pressure and holding time.
4. Holding time: User selectable and programmable holding time. The holding time can be set with digital display as per requirement.
5. Maximum material feed size up to 80 microns.
6. Feed materials: Bauxite, Limestone, Rock, Iron Ore, Tin and other materials.
7. Hydraulic Pressure should be maximum 250 bar.
8. Maximum fill height 20mm.
9. Steel Ring Size: 40mm. Special alloy ring to withstand 40 tons pressure.
10. Safety Features: Safety features should include a safety interlock and built in high accuracy pressure cut off device.
11. Motor Power: 3HP, 415V, 3 phase induction Motor of reputed make.
12. Pellet press should be supplied with all required accessories like pellet breaking tool, hydraulic oil, steel rings.
13. Calibration facility of load cell must be provided.
14. Installation, commissioning and training: The supplier shall provide the site training for equipment, demonstrate after successful installation & commissioning at State Geological Laboratory, Hazaribagh.
15. Warranty: Minimum Two (2) years standard warranty for the instrument and all the attached accessories from the date of commissioning.
16. Spares and Service Support: Supplier shall be responsible for supply of all sorts of spares including the consumables for at least 10 years that are required for the smooth functioning of Press Pellet Machine.

An undertaking letter must be provided regarding spares and service support for at least 10 years for the smooth functioning of the instrument.

3. QUANTITY OF THE ITEM:

Required quantity of Press Palette Machine: 01(One).

4. PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF BID:

The bid shall be submitted in **two (02) separate envelopes**, both placed inside a single main cover/envelope, as detailed below:

- j) Annual Turnover: The minimum average annual turnover for the bidder and the OEM should be **Rs. 50 lakhs** and **Rs. 100 lakhs** respectively in the last 03 financial years. Audited Balance sheets should be submitted along with the bid.
- k) Net worth: The bidder must have a positive net worth as per the latest audited financial statements. A certificate from the Statutory Auditor, certifying the positive net worth, shall be submitted along with the tender documents.
- l) Applicant should submit Notarized (*on non-judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 100*) Certificate that Company/Firm/Individual has not been blacklisted in the past by any organization. Non-compliance shall result in rejection of bid.
- m) Technical Catalogue of quoted product: The technical catalogue/brochure of the quoted product shall be enclosed with the Technical Bid. The bidder must also submit a declaration confirming compliance with the prescribed technical specifications. ***No deviation in this regard shall be permitted, and the bid of any agency not complying with the same shall be summarily rejected.***
- n) ISO 9001 & 14001 Certification: The bidder/OEM should have a valid ISO 9001 & 14001 Certification.
- o) Warranty Declaration: As mentioned in the technical specification under scope of work.
- p) OEM Authorization certificate: The bidder should submit OEM Authorization certificate along with the bid.
- q) Details of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) firm, if applicable (attach relevant documents).
- r) Previous relevant work experience: Bidder/OEM should submit copies of supply order along with performance certificates for the Press Palette Machine.

B.) Financial Bid: The Financial Bid should contain **unit price** of the Press Palette Machine including all applicable Taxes and delivery charges. The Financial Bid must be submitted strictly in the format attached with this NIT as **Annexure-I**.

5. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

- a) The envelopes, of “TECHNICAL Bid” AND “FINANCIAL Bid” (**Annexure-I**) must be clearly mentioned and should be properly sealed.
- b) Further, these envelopes are to be placed inside a big envelope and properly sealed.
- c) The NIT which are not submitted in above-mentioned manner shall be summarily rejected.
- d) NIT reference number and the subject matter must be clearly mentioned on the sealed envelope.

6. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- a) The Directorate reserves the right to accept or reject any quotation at any stage of the NIT (tendering) process without assigning any reason(s).
- b) The techno-commercial bids shall be evaluated by a duly constituted committee of the Directorate of Geology, Government of Jharkhand.
- c) In the **first stage**, the envelopes containing the technical bids shall be opened and examined by the evaluation committee. Based on the assessment of eligibility, qualifications, and technical responsiveness, bidders found suitable shall be declared as **technically qualified**.
- d) In the **second stage**, the financial bids of only the technically qualified bidders shall be opened and evaluated. The bidder quoting the lowest financial bid/rate (**L1**) shall be declared the **L1 Bidder/Firm/Supplier** and awarded the work order, subject to approval and fulfilment of all other terms and conditions of this NIT.
- e) The rates quoted shall be valid for **180 days**.
- f) Delivery Period: Within **90 days** of issue of Supply Order.
- g) Payment will be made after successful delivery and verification.
- h) Delivery of the item shall be made to the **designated location** of the Directorate of Geology.
- i) Only brand new and unused item will be accepted.
- j) Late or incomplete bids shall be rejected.

- k) **MSME Exemptions:** All exemptions related to Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) units shall be applicable exclusively as per the ‘Government of Jharkhand Procurement Policy 2014 (as amended vide memo no. 1342, dated-16.07.2019)’ & ‘Jharkhand Procurement of Goods and Services Manual, 2024’.
- l) **Performance Security Deposit:** The bidder shall deposit performance security in the form of Bank Guarantee (**Annexure-I**) at the rate of **2%** of the finalized L1 rate/total contract value of the subject matter of procurement subject to exemption or relaxation approved by the State Cabinet of the Government of Jharkhand *in accordance with para 6.5 (Performance security) of the “Jharkhand Procurement of Goods and Services Manual, 2024” and para- 11.0(i)(b) (Reduction in Transaction Cost) and para- 3.0 (Applicability) of the “Jharkhand Procurement Policy 2014 (as amended vide memo no. 1342, dated-16.07.2019)”*. The bank guarantee should be issued by any Nationalized/Nationalized Scheduled bank in favour of “**Director, Geology, Directorate of Geology, Department of Mines and Geology, Govt. of Jharkhand**” payable at Ranchi.
- m) The performance security deposit shall be retained as security for the **entire warranty period**, which shall be a minimum of **02 (two) years**. The Performance Security shall be refunded **without interest** upon satisfactory completion of the warranty period and fulfillment of all contractual obligations by the supplier.
- n) All **disputes** shall be settled within the territorial Jurisdiction of the **Court of Ranchi, Jharkhand** only.
